

Parking is available on street or at the Beachland Ballroom where we will go for lunch.

Then at approximately 11:30 we will go .2 mile down Waterloo to have lunch at the iconic \*Beachland Ballroom and Tavern <a href="http://beachlandballroom.com/">http://beachlandballroom.com/</a> where we will have separate checks and plenty of parking. If it is warm enough you may park there and walk back and forth to Praxis.

\*Built in 1950 as the Croatian Liberty Home, with the ballroom and tavern comprising the original structure the kitchen and back bar area were added in 1976. The Liberty Home was active on many social and political fronts and was a true Cleveland landmark before becoming Cleveland's most eclectic music club in the year 2000. Euclid Beach (operating from 1894 until 1969) was right at the north end of E. 156th St. Euclid and "Beachland" became the slang name for the whole North Collinwood neighborhood in those days
